



Biogen Multiple Sclerosis Award 2019

The **2019 Biogen Multiple Sclerosis Award** is sponsored by Biogen and is designed to recognise innovation and excellence in the delivery of pharmaceutical management and care of patients with multiple sclerosis in one of the following areas:

- Development of guidelines for the treatment of multiple sclerosis
- Education and/or counselling of patient(s) and their carer(s) about multiple sclerosis
- The role of a pharmacist in the multidisciplinary team
- Management strategies for smooth transition of multiple sclerosis care across the specialist/non-specialist care interface
- Use of pharmacist non-medical prescribing in multiple sclerosis
- Development and implementation of shared care guidance

Submissions may relate to any area of clinical practice which results in improvement to patients' overall multiple sclerosis management.

Applications are invited from UKCPA members who have completed work which demonstrates improvement in patient care/outcomes and/or improvement in the quality of multiple sclerosis prescribing. Innovative approaches with the potential to have benefits if replicated elsewhere are encouraged.

The winner will be awarded **£1500** to enable the lead author to present their work as a poster presentation at the UKCPA - Pharmacy Management Conference 2019, 8 November, London. Any remaining bursary funds should be used to further develop the award-winning work, to support CPD or to otherwise enhance patient care/Trust services.
